Inauguration and key address by the Director (Res.) DoP&T, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Govt. of India.

Sir/Madam,

The Constitution Bench of the Supreme Court, in the case of R.K. Sabharwal Vs State of Punjab, as well as, J.C. Mullick Vs Ministry of Railways had held that the reservation of jobs for the backward classes i.e., SC/ST/OBC should apply to posts and not to vacancies hereafter. Accordingly, post-based rosters were introduced by Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T), Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Govt. of India vide O.M.No.36012/2/96, Estt. (Res.) Dated July 02, 1997.

2. The outcomes of a considerable long period of 12 years of implementation of these orders are not very encouraging in terms of the realization of targeted goals. It would, however, be worthwhile and relevant to deliberate on various issues and major challenges that are faced by the appointing authorities. In view of this, the Institute which has been pioneer in the field of disseminating the information about post-based rosters (PBR), has now planned **residential training programme for the Chief Liaison Officers/Liaison Officers for SCs/STs/OBCs on Reservation Policy of Govt. of India from November 12 to 14, 2009 at Hotel Parkview, Sector 24, Chandigarh - 160 022. (Telephone 0172 - 4644495)**

03. The main objective of this training programme is two fold. One is to assess the extent of successful implementation of the instructions by the appointing authorities and recruiting agencies so as to identify the major obstacles in implementing the instructions; and, the other is to evolve strategies for smooth and proper implementation of these instructions. The deliberations would

largely focus on issues pertaining to vertical reservation (for SCs, STs and OBCs) and horizontal reservation (for Persons with Disabilities and Ex-servicemen). The Programme Schedule is attached herewith (Annexure-I).

04. The residential training programme is aimed at dissemination and propagation of the latest operatives including backlog of OBC posts in nutshell by which the Chief Liaison Officers / Liaison Officers for SCs/STs/OBC Unions / Employees may be reduced to minimum.

05. This residential training programme is being organised for Chief Liaison Officers, Liaison Officers and Officials dealing with SC/ST/OBC matters.

06. The Director (Res.), DoPT, Govt. of India who issues the orders in this regard, will deliver key address and clarify the doubts on spot. Indeed, a rare opportunity to interacting with the appropriate authority for which your officers have been looking for years.

07. You are, therefore, requested to send in nominations of your delegates along with the **non-refundable** fee of Rs. 17,648/- (participation fee = Rs. 16,000/- + Service tax @ 10.3% = Rs. 1,648/- = 17,648/-) per participant. The participation fee covers the cost of lodging & boarding, breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning & evening tea and study material. One room will be shared by two participants. If single room is required, the fee including Service Tax will be Rs. 22,060/- per participant. The boarding and lodging will be available from November 11, 2009 (afternoon) to November 15, 2009 (morning) under this arrangement. If boarding and lodging is required before and after the scheduled dates, the participant will be required to pay all inclusive an additional amount of Rs. 3,500/- per day. The participants who desire to stay in an independent room and wish to bring their spouse, will be required to pay all inclusive an additional amount of Rs. 8,000/- at the time of checking-in at the hotel towards the boarding and lodging of the spouse. However, non-resident participant will be required to pay only Rs. 10,478/- (participation fee = Rs. 9,500/- Service Tax @ 10.3% = 978/-). The crossed DD towards this **non-refundable** fee should be drawn in favour of ' **Institute of Public Administration** ', payable at Bangalore and should be sent along with the nomination letter.
