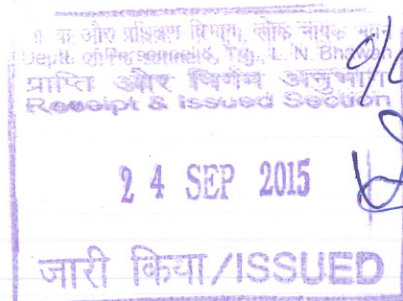
Sir,
