
Sir,

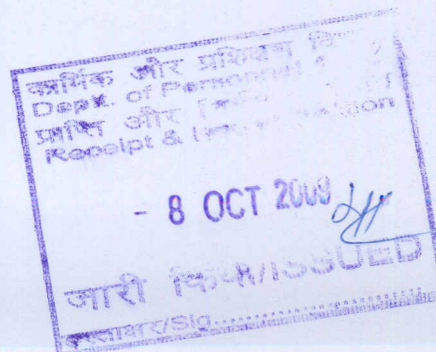


