The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 3.10.2005 and OM No.4/5/2005-CS.II dated 25.07.2006 and to say that in pursuance of CS.I Section's Order No. 21/42/2003-CS.I (A) dated 13.7.2009, it has been decided, by the competent authority, to extend the range of seniority for the Select List year 2003 for Assistant Grade (Seniority Quota) of CSS.

2. The extended size of the Select List of Assistant Grade(SQ) of CSS for the Year 2003 shall be as under :

3. The total number of additional vacancies to be filled in the extended Select List 2003 against Seniority Quota is 2151. In order to avoid any disparity which may arise if the promotions are made on the basis of cadre seniority, the competent authority has also approved the range of seniority for promotion of UDCs for the Select List Year 2003 for Assistant Grade (Seniority Quota) of CSS on the basis of the CSL of UDCs prepared, circulated vide O.M. No. 20/19/2009-CS.II dated 15.5.2009 and finalized by this Department, on the basis of information received from the cadre authorities.

The officials covered in the extended Select List may be promoted immediately subject to DPC and Vigilance clearance for inclusion in the Select List of Assistant's for the year 2003(SQ). A list of UDCs of Select List for the year 1987(part) to 1992 alongwith their present posting is enclosed at Annexure I-VI.

- 5. The cadre authorities are requested to take immediate action for appointment of officials who are found fit for promotion to the Assistant Grade by conducting the DPC within a period of one month. The cadre authorities must ensure that no ineligible/unfit/debarred official for promotion for the Select List Year 2003 is appointed to the grade. It may be ensured that no vigilance case is either pending or contemplated against the officer being appointed. Action taken in that regard may also be intimated to this Department as also about the officer who could not be found fit either by DPC or vigilance clearance. All those officials who are eligible for promotion may be promoted as is where is basis i.e. in the cadres where they are presently working as Assistant on ad-hoc basis within the sanctioned strength in that cadre. A copy of the appointment orders may be endorsed to this Department for records. The seniority of theses officials would be as per the CSL finalized by this Department.

Further, the promotion/ appointment of these officials would be subject to the outcome of court case No. 13245-60/2005 filed by Shri Kailash Chander Vs Union of India pending in the High Court of Delhi, O.A. No. 1083/2007 and M.A. No. 1171/2007 filed by Shri Sauranshu Sinha Vs UOI in the CAT, PB, New Delhi and Contempt Petition (Civil) 131/09 in O.A. No. 1061/2004 in M.A. No. 615/09 filed by Central Secretariat Non-gazette Employees Union & Ors. Vs UOI & ors in the CAT, PB, New Delhi.
