OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Continuation of ad-hoc appointment in the grade of Assistant of CSS – reg.

---

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM of even number dated 30.06.2008/01.07.2008 on the subject mentioned above, vide which Cadres were permitted to continue the ad-hoc appointment of those UDCs upto CSL No. 447/94 (General & SC) and eligible UDCs belonging to ST category of Select List Years upto 2000, recommended for appointment to the Grade of Assistant of CSS, on ad-hoc basis, by this Department from time to time, for the period upto 31.12.2008. Further continuance of these ad-hoc appointments and the ad-hoc appointments made after the last extension i.e., all UDCs of the Select List Year 1994 in respect of General & SC category and upto Select List Year 2000 in respect of ST category, has been reviewed in this Department. Since the availability of regular Assistants through normal modes of recruitment prescribed in the CSS Rules may take some more time, it has been decided, with the approval of the competent authority, that the period of ad-hoc appointment made in Assistant Grade of CSS may be extended for a further period of six months, i.e., upto 30.06.2009 or till regular Assistants become available, whichever is earlier.

2. Extension of the ad-hoc appointment would be continued only if the ad-hoc Assistants attend and qualify the mandatory 'A' Level training as and when nominated by CS.I (Training) Section of this Department failing which their ad-hoc appointment would be terminated.

3. Other terms and conditions mentioned in the relevant OMs will remain unchanged.
