ORDER

WHEREAS the "deemed relieving" orders of 88 Assistant Section Officers under RTP were issued vide order of even number dated 01.06.2018. The officers were to be relieved from their present Ministries/ Departments by 08.06.2018.

3. Attention is invited to Para 22.1 of O.M. dated 16.07.2015 which states as under:


"In terms of Rule 19 of CSS Rules, 2009, the Department of Personnel & Training shall be the competent authority to transfer a cadre officer of any grade from one cadre unit to another cadre unit and it shall be duty of the concerned cadre unit to relieve the officer concerned within 45 days of the transfer order. If not relieved within 45 days, the officer concerned shall be deemed to have been relieved and thereafter the officer shall not be entitled to draw any salary and allowances from the Ministry/ Dept. From which transferred".

4. Keeping in view the ongoing Parliament session, Ministries/ Departments may ensure that the officers are relieved by 17.08.2018 compulsorily, failing which the concerned officers will not be entitled to draw any salary and allowances from their present Ministries after 17.08.2018.

The Ministries concerned are also informed that they should not wait for substitutes to join and they should relieve ASOs from their Ministries within the stipulated time and in case any substitute does not join or is not available for any reason, the same can be brought to the notice of DoPT, so that suitable substitutes could be posted by CS.I Division.
