**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Sub: Select List of Section Officers' Grade for the year 2005 against Examination Quota on the basis of Combined Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2005 held by the Union Public Service Commission – release of supplementary list – allocation of candidates – reg.**

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The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 5.6.2009, 9.7.2009 and 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2010 and to state that the Union Public Service Commission, vide their letter No. 1/16(1)/2007-E.VI has forwarded a supplementary list recommending 04 candidates comprising 3 General and 1 SC in Category I for appointment as Section officer of CSS. Out of 04 candidates recommended by the UPSC, only 3 candidates(General) are effectively available for consideration for appointment in Category I as Section Officers in the Select List of the year 2005 .

2. Allocation of candidates has been made having regard to the vacancies available in various cadres vis-à-vis candidates available, and the same are indicated as under:-

4. The candidates included in the Select List of 2005 of the Section Officers' Grade of the respective cadres as indicated in the table above may be appointed to the Grade immediately subject to their being clear from vigilance angle.

5. As per rotation policy applicable in the case of CSS Officers, no correspondence/request either from the individual or Ministries/Departments shall be entertained for retention/change of cadre etc. or any approach whatsoever. Letter/correspondence received to such effect shall be treated as canvassing and the same shall attract administrative/disciplinary action under the relevant rules.



UOI pending in the Hon'ble CAT, Delhi.
