**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Sub: Select List of Section Officers' Grade for the year 2005 against Examination Quota on the basis of Combined Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2005 held by the Union Public Service Commission.**

\*\*\*\*\*

The undersigned is directed to say that the Department of Personnel & Training had reported 196 vacancies (General-160, SC-17 and ST-19) to be filled up on the basis of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2005 conducted by the UPSC. Out of the 144 candidates recommended by the UPSC, only 127 (General-112, Scheduled Castes: 08, Scheduled Tribes: 07) candidates are effectively available for consideration for appointment as Section Officers in the Select List of the year 2005. Allocations of candidates has been made having regard to the vacancies reported by various cadres vis-à-vis candidates available, and the same are indicated in the Annexure to this O.M. As the eligibility of Grade 'C' Stenographers (PA) is sub-judice, allocation/appointment of such candidates would be based on the outcome of the case No. W.P.(C) No. 4876/2007 in the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi .

2. The candidates included in the Select List of 2005 of the Section Officers' Grade of the respective cadres as in the Annexure to this O.M. may be appointed to the Grade immediately subject to their being clear from vigilance angle.

3. The cadre authorities are requested to initiate the process of appointment of the candidates immediately. It may be specifically mentioned in the appointment orders of the candidates concerned that they should join the duty in the cadre allocated within 30 days from the date of issue of the orders for appointment, failing which their candidature shall be cancelled and the dossier(s) of the candidate(s) concerned returned to the UPSC. Appointment to the post of Section Officer would be effective from the date of joining duty as Section Officer.

4. Some of the Ministries/Departments have requested for retention of some of the officers within the same cadre. These representations have been considered at the

highest level and the same have been rejected, as they are not in consonance with the rotation transfer policy applicable in the case of CSS Officers. No correspondence/request either from the individual or Ministries/Departments shall be entertained for retention/change of cadre etc.



It may also be brought to the notice of all the Officers who figure in the Annexure that their appointments shall be subject to the outcome of the Court case W.P.(C) No. 13245-60/2005 filed by Kailash Chander vs. UOI pending in the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi and OA No. 1083/2007 & MA No. 1171/2007 filed by Shri Sauranshu Sinha Vs. UOI pending in the Hon'ble CAT, Delhi. The seniority of the Assistants recommended for appointment shall be subject to the final outcome of the Writ Petition (C) No. 4876/2007 in the matter of the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service Association Vs The Central Secretariat Service Direct Recruit Assistants' Association.

6 The examination dossiers of the candidates are sent herewith, for retention as a part of personal file of the officer(s) concerned. A copy of the appointment order may be endorsed to both the UPSC and this Department for record.
