OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Stepping up of pay of Directly Recruited Section Officers recruited through Civil Services Examination to the level of pay guaranteed to their junior Departmental Section Officers.

As the cadres are aware, the benefit of fixation of pay at two incremental stages higher than the minimum of pay scale revised by the 4th Central Pay Commission, was restored with effect from 26th October, 1989 vide this Department's O.M. No.5/16/88-CS.I, dated 21st March, 1994, in respect of Assistants and Gr. 'C' Stenos on promotion to the Section Officers Grade of CSS and Gr. 'A & B' Merged of CSSS.

2. A number of representations and references were received from individual officers as well as from various Ministries/ Departments requesting for the restoration of the benefit of stepping up of pay in respect of the directly recruited Section Officers. The matter has been examined in consultation with the Estt. Div. of this Department and the Ministry of Finance and it has been decided that in cases where a Senior direct-recruit Section Officer is drawing less pay than a promotee Section Officer who is appointed from the same or later date by virtue of the pay of the promotee Section Officer having been fixed at the guaranteed minimum of Rs.2120 in the revised scale of Rs.2000-3500, the pay of the direct-recruit will be stepped up by the concerned cadre authority under FR.27, with effect from the date of promotion of the promotee officer, to the stage of Rs.2120. The increment after the stepping up will be admissible to such direct-recruit Section Officers on completion of necessary qualifying service reckoned from the date from which the pay is so stepped up. The pay will be re-fixed on this basis notionally and actual benefits thereof will be given from the date of confirmation as Section Officer or 26.10.1989, whichever is later.
