OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**Sub: Select List of Section Officers' Grade for the year 2005 against Examination Quota on the basis of Combined Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2005 held by the Union Public Service Commission – release of supplementary list – allocation of candidates – reg.**

\*\*\*\*\*

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 5.6.2009 and to state that the Union Public Service Commission, vide their letter No. 1/16(1)/2007-E.VI dated 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 has forwarded a supplementary list recommending 43 candidates comprising 37 General and 6 SC in Category I for appointment as Section officer of CSS. Out of 43 candidates recommended by the UPSC, only **31 candidates(28 General and 3 SCs )** are effectively available for consideration for appointment in Category I as Section Officers in the Select List of the year 2005 . As the eligibility of Grade 'C' Stenographers (PA) is sub-judice, allocation/appointment of Stenographers Grade 'C', who opted for Category I i.e. Section Officers' Grade of CSS would be based on the outcome of the case No. W.P.(C) No. 4876/2007 in the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi .

2. Allocation of candidates has been made having regard to the vacancies available in various cadres vis-à-vis candidates available, and the same are indicated in the Annexure to this O.M.

3. The cadre authorities, where the officials are presently working are requested to relieve the candidates immediately. While relieving, it may clearly be indicated that the official is clear from vigilance angle.

4. The candidates included in the Select List of 2005 of the Section Officers' Grade of the respective cadres as in the Annexure to this O.M. may be appointed to the Grade immediately subject to their being clear from vigilance angle.

5. As per rotation policy applicable in the case of CSS Officers, no correspondence/request either from the individual or Ministries/Departments shall be entertained for retention/change of cadre etc. or any approach whatsoever. Letter/correspondence received to such effect shall be treated as canvassing and the same shall attract administrative/disciplinary action under the relevant rules.



It may also be brought to the notice of all the Officers who figure in the Annexure that their appointments shall be subject to the outcome of the Court case W.P.(C) No. 13245-60/2005 filed by Kailash Chander vs UOI pending in the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi and OA No. 1083/2007 & MA No. 1171/2007 filed by Shri Sauranshu Sinha Vs. UOI pending in the Hon'ble CAT, Delhi. The seniority of the Assistants recommended for appointment shall be subject to the final outcome of the Writ Petition © No. 4876/2007 in the matter of the Central Secretariat Stenographers Service Association Vs The Central Secretariat Service Direct Recruit Assistants Association.

7 The examination dossiers of the candidates are sent herewith, for retention as a part of personal file of the officer(s) concerned. A copy of the appointment order may be endorsed to both the UPSC and this Department for record.
