
**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: - Promotion of Steno. Grade A&B (merged) of CSSS to the posts of Principal Private Secretary on ad-hoc basis - regarding.**

The undersigned is directed to say that it has been decided to promote 22 regular Steno. Grade 'A' & 'B' (merged) (PS) of CSSS whose names are given in the Annexure to this OM to the Private Secretary Grade (designated as Principal Private Secretary) of CSSS in the scale of (Rs.15600-39100 + Grade pay Rs. 6600) on ad-hoc basis for the period upto 31.12.2010 or till the posts are filled up on regular basis, or until further orders, whichever is earlier, and nominate them to the cadre shown against their names for appointment as PPS.
