
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: M.A. No. 2934/2010 in O.A. No. 1083/2007 in the matter of Shri Sauranshu Sinha and Ors. Vs. Union of India and Ors.- forwarding of the copies thereof.

The undersigned is directed to say that an Original Application (OA) No. 1083/2007 has been filed by Shri Sauranshu Sinha & Ors. in the Hon'ble CAT, PB, New Delhi for quashing of the appointments made to the post of Section Officer against Seniority Quota for the year 2003 to the extent the said appointments exceed the vacancies reported earlier (255) to the UPSC for filling up through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination Quota (LDCEQ) for 2003. On a Miscellaneous Application (MA) No. 2934/2010 filed by the Applicants in the said OA praying for impleadment of all the private parties, who have been appointed in excess of 255 to the post of Section Officer through Seniority Quota, it has been ordered by the Hon'ble Tribunal that should the private parties wish to argue anything, they are at liberty to do so on the date fixed i.e. 7.2.2011 at 10.30 a.m. or any other date to which the case may be adjourned either in person or through an advocate appointed by the private parties for the purpose. The Hon'ble CAT has also directed to take notice that in default of their appearance on the date fixed, the case will be heard ex-parte.

2. The Hon'ble Tribunal further directed that the copies would be supplied to the private parties through the applicants to the Respondent No. 1 i.e. Department of Personnel & Training. Accordingly, necessary copies each consisting of (i) the Original Application (OA No. 1083/2007), (ii) Miscellaneous Application (MA) No. 2934/2010 and (iii) the copy of the order of the Hon'ble Tribunal Dated 15.12.2010 provided by the Applicants in the OA have been forwarded to the concerned cadre units for supply to most of the private Respondents, who are either working or retired from the concerned cadre unit. Copies in respect of the remaining few cadre units will be forwarded to the concerned cadre units as soon as additional copies are received from the applicants.

3. All the private parties as mentioned in para-1 above are requested to collect their copies from the concerned cadre units, where they are presently working or from where they retired. In case of any query in this regard, the concerned section in CS-I may be contacted (Phone. No. 24642706).
