**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Extension in tenure of Shri Nilkanth Avhad, IAS(PB:99) as Counsellor (Economic) in the Economic Wing of the Embassy of India, Washington DC.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to Department of Economic Affairs' OM No.A-19011/1/2014-Admn.III dated 26.08.2019 on the subject cited above and to say that Appointments Committee of the Cabinet [ACC] has approved the proposal of the Department of Economic Affairs for extension in tenure of Shri Nilkanth Avhad, IAS(PB:99), Counsellor (Economic) in the Economic Wing of the Embassy of India, Washington DC for a period of 3 months beyond his approved tenure i.e. beyond 15.08.2019 and up to 15.11.2019 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

2. It may also be noted that a deputationist officer is deemed to have been relieved on the date of expiry of the deputation period unless the competent authority has with requisite approvals, extended the period of deputation, in writing, prior to its date of expiry. In the event of officer overstaying for any reason whatsoever, he/she is liable for disciplinary action and other adverse Civil/Service consequences which would include the period of overstay not being counted for service for the purpose of pension and that any increment due during the period of overstay being deferred with cumulative effect, till the date on which the officer rejoins in his parent cadre. Proceedings for deemed resignation from service may also be initiated. This may also be brought to the notice of the officer.




