OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Processing of appointments in Central Public Enterprises falling within the purview of Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) - Vigilance Clearance reg.

\*\*\*\*\*

The existing instructions on processing of the proposals for appointments in the Central Public Undertakings communicated vide this Department's O.M.No.27(28)EO/91(ACC) dated 17.3.1992 (copy enclosed) envisage that the Ministries/Departments should send the proposals only after obtaining vigilance clearance within a time frame, for being placed before the ACC for its consideration.

2. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet in one of the proposals relating to extension in tenure of a Board level appointee noted that the concerned Ministry took 15 months to get CVC clearance in respect of the concerned officer. As a result of this, the officer continued to hold the post in question beyond the expiry of his approved tenure for the said period.
3. The Committee has directed that the necessary vigilance clearance should be obtained by the concerned administrative Ministry/Department before the expiry of the approved tenure of an incumbent and CVC should also take up such cases on top priority basis.
4. The Ministries/~~Departments~~ etc. are requested to ensure compliance of the aforesaid instructions.
