
Subject: Cadre Clearance to Dr. Vasanthakumar N, IAS (AGMUT:2004) for taking up long term foreign assignment to University of Manitoba (UOM) as Executive Director, Uttar Pradesh Technical Support Unit (UP TSU), Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh-reg

Reference: Ministry of Home Affairs' O.M.No, 14046/41/2012-UTS.I dated 21.06.2018.

The undersigned is directed to convey that the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) has approved the proposal for grant of cadre clearance to Dr. Vasanthakumar N., IAS (AGMUT:2004) to take up Long Term Foreign Assignment to University of Manitoba (UoM), as Executive Director, Uttar Pradesh Technical Support Unit (UP TSU) in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, under Rule 6(2)(ii) of the AIS(Cadre)Rules, 1954, for a period of three years from the date of assumption of charge of the post or until further orders, whichever is earlier, in relaxation of the condition of serving for at least two years before being eligible for undertaking foreign assignments/consultancies, on return from Training or Study leave.

2 Ministry of Home Affairs is requested to send a copy of order of relieving Dr. Vasanthakumar N, IAS (AGMUT:2004) for the aforesaid assignment along with a copy of terms and conditions of the said assignment to this Department for information and records.

3. It may also be noted that the deputationist officer is deemed to have been relieved on the date of expiry of the deputation period unless the Competent Authority has with requisite approvals, extended the period of deputation, in writing, prior to its date of expiry. In the event of the officer overstaying for any reasons whatsoever, he/she is liable for disciplinary action and other adverse Civil/Service consequences which would include the period of overstay not being counted for service for the purpose of pension and that any increment due during the period of overstay being deferred with cumulative effect, till the date on which the officer rejoins in his parent cadre. Proceedings for deemed resignation from service would also be initiated. This may be brought to the notice of the officer.
