OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:-Grant of Age Concession to Blind, Deaf-Mute and Orthopaedically handicapped persons for appointment to Class III and IV (now Group C and D) posts under the Central Government.

.....

The question of further liberalisation of age concessions granted to Blind, Deaf-Mute and Orthopaedically handicapped persons, has been under consideration of the Government for some time and it has now been decided, in partial modification of the provisions of the O.M.No. 4/3/68-Estt.(D) dated 15.4.69, that for purposes of appointment to class III and class IV (now Group C and D) posts, filled through the Employment Exchanges, the upper age limit in the case of Blind, Deaf-Mute and Orthopaedically handicapped persons shall be relaxed upto 10 years.
