OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Fixation of pay of Incumbents released from  
Armed Forces and re-employed in civil posts.



The undersigned is directed to invite attention to the Min. of Finance O.M.No. 6 (8)-E.III(A)/63, dated 16.3.1966, under which the ex-combatant clerks, whose service in the Army was treated as equivalent to the service as LDC/Junior clerk in civil Departments, were allowed to get their pay fixed either under that Ministry's O.M.No.8(34)-E.III/57, dated 25.11.1958, as amended from time to time, or under the O.M.No.6(8)-E.III(A)/63, dated 11.4.1963, on their re-employment as clerks on civil side. The benefit of this option of pay fixation under either set of orders was extended to the ex-combatant Storemen retired/released from the Armed Forces and re-employed as Storemen in civil posts, vide Ministry of Finance O.M.No.4(2)-E.III(A)/68, dated 19th March, 1968. It was laid that this option should be exercised within three months of the date of re-employment of the ex-combatant clerks/storemen in the civil Departments on the same posts and the option once exercised shall be final.

2. It has, however, been found in some cases that the above orders were not specifically brought to notice of the individuals concerned, which has resulted in their not opting for either set of orders for their pay fixation within the prescribed time limit. To obviate the difficulties in this regard, it has been decided that in future at the time of re-employment of an ex-combatant clerk/storeman on civil posts, a reference to the different orders concerning pay fixation might be made and it might be mentioned that he has to exercise the said option within three months of his re-employment and such an option will be treated as final.


