Subject: RELAXATION OF AGE LIMIT IN FAVOUR OF TA PERSONNEL
FOR PURPOSE OF EMPLOYMENT IN CIVIL POSTS

The undersigned is directed to say that the Government of INDIA have decided that Territorial Army personnel shall be treated as "Retrenched Central Government Employees" for purposes of orders contained in this Ministry's O.M. No. 4/13/54 dated the 14th January 1955, provided they have served on the permanent staff of a TA unit or have been embodied for service under TA Rule 33 for a continuous period of not less than six months. For this purpose, viz. for purposes of age relaxation their entire period of embodied service (including broken periods) in the Territorial Army shall be taken into account.
