Subject: All India Services-Question whether suspension
of a selection grade officer would release a
vacancy in the selection grade-Regarding.

Sir,

A question has been raised whether the suspension
of a selection grade Officer automatically releases a
vacancy in the selection grade for promotion of a senior
time scale officer to that vacancy. It is hereby clarified
that a vacancy in the selection grade is not released by
suspension of the officer as (a) in the event of his
complete exoneration he would be entitled to draw
selection grade pay during the entire period in which
he was kept under suspension and (b) in the event of his
being awarded any penalty, his subsistence allowance, or pay
and allowances would be regularised with reference to
the Selection grade pay.
