Subject:- IAS (Pay) Rules, Amendment to -

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to this Department's letter No.11030/20/87-AIS(II) dated the 31st March, 1987 on the above subject and to say that a question has been raised whether, in the case of an officer promoted to the IAS, the computation of 9 years and 13 years under para 4 of the aforesaid letter shall be reckoned from the date of continuous officiation in a cadre post or the date of appointment to the Service. It is clarified that an option may be given to the member of the Service concerned, to count the period

(a) from the month following the month in which he was appointed to the Service;

OR

(b) from the month following the month he started officiating continuously in a cadre post immediately preceding his appointment to the Service.

2. These instructions shall apply, mutatis-mutandis, to the I.P.S. and the I.F.S.
