Subject: Regulation of pay in the Senior Time Scale of
officers promoted from the State Services in the
IAS, or appointment to the IAS - admissibility of
pay protection in the Junior Administrative Grade
and Selection Grade - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to our letter
No.11030/25/87-AIS(II), dated the 21st January, 1988, according
to which the pay being drawn by the officers promoted from State
Services to the IAS beyond the maximum of the Senior Time Scale
of the IAS gets protected. The difference of pay drawn by the
State Services and that admissible in the IAS is allowed as
personal pay subject to the conditions that pay plus personal
pay shall not exceed Rs.5700/- per month and the personal pay
thus granted shall be absorbed in future increments/increases
in pay. A question has been raised whether personal pay thus
allowed to protect the pay being drawn in State Services by
these officers would continue to be protected on their further
appointment to the Junior Administrative Grade and Selection
Grade of the IAS.

2. The matter has been carefully examined. The Junior
Administrative Grade and Selection Grade of the Service are
more or less extensions of the Senior Scale of the IAS.
Further, both these grades are non-functional in nature not
involving higher duties and responsibilities. It has, there-
fore, been decided that the benefits allowed vide the above
said letter dated 21.1.88 envisaging protection of pay on
appointment of promotee officers to the Senior Time Scale of
the IAS shall continue to be made available on their further
appointment to the Junior Administrative Grade and the
Selection Grade. It will, however remain subject to the
condition that the personal pay thus allowed, together with
pay, shall be subject to the maximum of Rs.5700/- per month
and the personal pay shall be absorbed in future increments/
increases in pay.
