
Subject: I.F.S. (Pay) Rules, 1968 - Regulation of pay of
members of the Indian Forest Service in the Selection
Grade.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the question of regulation of pay of members of Indian Forest Service in the Selection Grade has been considered by the Government in the context of the representations that a member of the I.F.S. will be drawing pay of Rs. 4200/- in the J.A.G. at the time he becomes eligible for appointment to the Selection Grade in the scale of Rs. 4100-5300 and as such, his pay is fixed at Rs. 4100/- with Rs. 100/- as personal pay, to be absorbed in future increments unlike in the case of promotion to Selection Grade in the case of IAS and IPS.

2. It has therefore been decided that the initial pay of a member of the I.F.S. on appointment to the Selection Grade shall be fixed at Rs. 4350/- per month in the Selection Grade. The increments in the selection grade will be admissible on completion of one year in the Selection Grade from the date of appointment to the Selection Grade.


