Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to the instructions contained in this Department's letter No. 1/17/72-AIS(II) dated the 22nd March, 1974, on the subject cited above and to say that this Department has been advised that if the officiation of a member of a State Service is disapproved for non-conformity with the rules, he would be entitled to receive the pay admissible to him under the relevant rules of the State Service. It has accordingly been decided that the following portion appearing in the sub-paragraph under paragraph 2 of the letter dated the 22nd March, 1974, referred to above, should be treated as deleted:

"These modifications/clarifications are, however, subject to the condition that pay admissible to a member of the State Civil Service during the period of unapproved officiation in a cadre post in terms of these instructions shall not result in the officer being remunerated at a rate of pay more than that allowed to the officer in the senior time scale of the All India Service during the period of officiation which is in accordance with rule 9 of the Cadre Rules. In a case where a member of the service will be entitled to be remunerated at a higher rate under these instructions the pay of the officer during the period he holds the cadre post and which has not been

approved by the Central Government, will be restricted to the initial pay fixed for him at the time of commencement of such officiation."
