2. As informed during the meeting the following table lists in brief the clarification sought by your organization and the Government response thereon on the basis of the various clauses of the RFP document:-



	Can an institution associate with another agency and apply as a consortium.	Applicants may collaborate to enhance their qualification and in such an event a memorandum of understanding must be included as a part of the technical proposal. The requirements / conditions indicated in clause 7, clause 3.1 and para 9.3 (c), of Part-I Section-II, Clause 15A(ii) of Part-II of Section II and Form TECH2 in Section V the RFP should also be kept in view.

3. The above clarification should not be construed in any manner to be amounting to any decision of the Government on either shortlisting or selection of the participating organizations.
