Subject:- AIS(Conduct) Rules, 1968- Rule 13(1) (b) of AIS(Conduct) Rules, 1968 – Obtaining prior approval of the Government before negotiating for or taking up any employment by members of All India Service.


Sir,

As per the provisions of Rule 13(1)(b) of AIS(Conduct) Rules, 1968, members of All India Service are required to obtain prior permission of the Government before they negotiate for, or undertake any other employment.

2. It has come to the notice of the Government of India that some members of Service have negotiated private employment without the specific permission of the Government. Instances have also come to light where a member of service has joined a private sector company without waiting further for the final acceptance of his resignation. It has been viewed seriously and has been decided that violation of the provisions of the aforesaid Rule is a grave misconduct, entailing initiation of disciplinary proceedings for major penalty under Rule 6 of AIS (D&A) Rules, 1969. All the members of All India Services are, therefore, advised to obtain prior permission of the Government before negotiating for or undertaking any other employment.

3. It is requested that these instructions may be brought to the notice of all the members of the All India Services.
