Dear Sir,

The Government of India has been organising Mid-Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence for the last many year. The basic objective of these events is to increase exposure of IAS/IPS/IFoS and other civil officers to the military to meet unforeseen situations at short notice. Such interactions are likely to benefit both the Armed Forces and Civil Services officers by mutual learning from each other's strength and also by imbibing the best points of each other's work culture, ethos and customs. This, in the long run, is expected to help them to combat future challenges to national security in a better manner.

2. The Joint Civil-Military interaction course are conducted at the tactical and operational level. A detailed schedule has been worked out by the DoP&T, Training Division in consultation with Ministry of Defence for the various programmes to be conducted at the State Administrative Training Institutes and Armed Forces Organisations in various Regions of the country during 2014-15 Each State is being requested to depute officers for the training/interactions being conducted in and around it.

3. Ministry of Defence has proposed to conduct a three day **Mid Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers on 'Enhancing inter operationality to meet emerging challenges' at Maritime Warfare Centre, Kochi from 3-5 September, 2014.** Therefore, it is requested that **at least three (3) officers**, one each from IAS, IPS and IFoS (DM/ADM;SSP/SP/Addl. SP and DFO level), may kindly be deputed from your State for participating in the Programme.

4. Since these interactions have been very carefully planned with the active involvement of various organizations, I shall be grateful if suitable officers are deputed to participate in the programme, their telephone, mobile, fax, email details are shared with the nodal officer of the event and suitable joining instructions are served to the officer concerned. In case, officers from the All India Services are not available, kindly depute officers belonging to the State Civil Services (SCS) who are working at the cutting-edge level in the districts. **JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR MID CAREER INTERACTION  
BETWEEN ARMED FORCES AND IAS/IPS OFFICERS**

1. Director and Staff of MWC (K) welcome the participants of the Mid Career Interaction between Armed Forces and IAS/IPS officers to the Maritime Warfare Centre at Kochi. These instructions are forwarded to guide you on various administrative issues.
2. **MWC (K).** Maritime Warfare Centre (MWC) at Kochi is a premier training institute of the Indian Navy under the aegis of Headquarters Southern Naval Command specialised in conduct of training in the domain of Maritime Operations. MWC (K) has its origins in a Tactical Unit formed at Kochi in Jun 51, which was commissioned as a 'Tactical School' on 02 Oct 54. The centre is headed by Commodore G Prakash, an alumni of National Defence Academy, commissioned in the Indian Navy on 01 Jul 1985
3. **Schedule.** The Interactions between the participants would be held at the MWC auditorium from 03 to 05 Sep 14. A tentative schedule for the interactions is enclosed. In addition to lectures, the participants would be divided into syndicates to facilitate inter agency coordination.
4. **Accommodation.** All outstation participants are to forward their arrival details and request for accommodation at the earliest for making the necessary arrangements in the Officers Mess. In view of a large number of under trainee officers residing in the Officers Mess it is advisable for all participants to draw advance for hotel stay. MOUs exist between the SNC and various premium hotels for accommodation at existing government entitlements. In case of shortage of suitable accommodation the participants will be accommodated in hotels.
5. **Temporary Pass.** All civilian officers would be issued with Temporary Pass for movement in and out of the Naval Base. These are to be returned on completion of the course.
6. **Transport.** Transport to and fro from accommodation arranged by SNC would be provided to all participants.
