- G.S.R...- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training, the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Group 'B' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2003, in so far as they relate to the posts of Administrative Officer (Account) and Junior Accounts Officer, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Administrative Officer (Accounts) and Junior Accounts Officer in the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie under the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievance and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training, namely:
- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training, the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie, Administrative Officer (Accounts) and Junior Accounts Officer (Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2015.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification, pay band, grade pay or pay scale. The number of post, their classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc. The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification.- No person,-
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax. Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the other backward classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(B) The departmental Junior Accounts Officer in the pay band 2, Rs.9300-34800 with grade pay of Rs.4200/- with five years' regular service in grade and having educational qualifications and experience prescribed for considering appointment on deputation basis shall also be considered alongwith outsiders and in case such person is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

Note1: The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: The period of deputation (including short term contract) including the period of deputation (including short term contract) in another *excadre* post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 3: The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 4: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay
