3. The States/UTs and Regional Sports Boards are requested to consider entering their teams for the All India Civil Services Carom Tournament. The entries may be sent in the prescribed proforma direct to contact officer indicated in paragraph 8 with a copy to the Board's office on or before 25. 12. 2015. Entries received after the last date will not be entertained.
4. List of players along with photocopy of their Identity Card should be authenticated by the authorized officer under his signature & seal. All the participants shall carry their Identity Cards/Identity Slip for verification of eligibility criteria by the Organizing Committee/Representatives of the Board at the venue of the All India Civil Services Tournaments. Addresses, Telephone Numbers, E-mail Addresses may also be indicated in the Entry Form.
5. Every participating team must bring two flags representing their States/UTs/RSBs with them. Any team exhibiting logo or name of offices/ Team other than given in the entry form will be disqualified.

6. All the participants shall maintain strict discipline on and off the venue of the tournament. Any act of indiscipline/misbehavior/misconduct will attract the provision of CCS (Conduct) Rules as they are "ON DUTY" during All India Civil Services Tournaments.

7. The information about Rules and Regulation, Entry Form, change in dates/venue/cancellation etc. about the AICS Tournament is/will be available on www.persmin.nic.in. All the participant teams are, therefore, requested to check from the website/organizers of the tournament about any possible change before starting their journey.
