TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT
OF SHRI G.N. MEHRA AS A CONSULTANT

1. The services of Shri G.N. Mehra will be available on a full time basis with the Central Government, to serve as Chairman of the State Advisory Committee;
2. Shri G.N. Mehra shall hold the said appointment on honorary basis from the forenoon of 1st January, 2001 till 30th September, 2001 or until further orders, whichever is earlier;
3. Shri Mehra shall be eligible for Travelling Allowance and Daily Allowance at the rates admissible under the Central Government Rules to the Officers of his rank and status and also the normal facilities of telephone and transport; and
4. Shri Mehra will act in accordance with the Guidelines issued by the Central Government (Department of Personnel & Training) regarding constitution of State Advisory Committee issue vide letter No. 28/1/2000-SR(S) dated 21/22.12.2000.
