Sub.- Decision on the representations of Junior Engineers of Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand under the guidelines of SC/ST.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and to say that the request of the following Junior Engineers of Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand for their re-allocation under the guidelines of SC/ST Policy was considered during the Advisory Committee's meeting held on 18.07.2014.

2. The Committee was informed that following employees had requested for revision of their allocation as per the guidelines for allocation of SC/ST employees dated 28/29.07.2008 and clarification dated 24.06.2010. The Committee was further informed that these officers joined service after the appointed day hence they are not eligible for allocation under UP Reorganization Act, 2000.
3. The recommendations of the Committee are as under:


"The Committee considered 39 representations received from the SC / ST employees requesting for allocation under guidelines for allocation of SC / ST employees. Cases at **Sl.No.7(20) to 7(23) were recommended for rejection** on the ground that they were not in service on the appointed day."
