- 3. Nomination of the members in the Committees, wherever required, will be made by the authority competent to approve the transfers in the respective grades. The Committees will make recommendations and final decision will be taken by the authority competent to approve the transfers.
- 4. The Committees would normally make recommendations in accordance with the transfer policy notified by various orders in this regard, and also considering the administrative convenience and exigencies. The seniority, age of the officer, his/her past posting profile, nature of duties attached to the post, place of posting, vacancies in various Ministries/ Departments etc would also be considered.
- 5. The transfer policy and guidelines prescribing the tenure for posting of CSS officers are only directory in nature and not mandatory. Any officer can be transferred by the competent authority at any time to any post on administrative grounds.
