
Subject:-Stenographer Grade 'C' Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2004 - Nomination of qualified candidates.



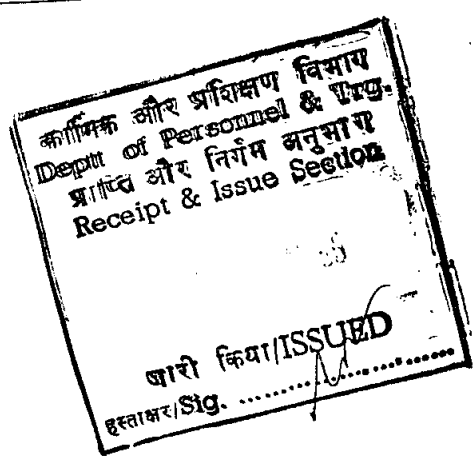
