## TRAINING CIRCULAR

Subject : A Group Training Course for Expert on Flood-Related Disaster mitigation to be held in Japan from 28/9/2009 to 18/9/2010.

The undersigned is directed to state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), under the Technical Cooperation Programme of the Government of Japan has invited applications for a Group Training Course for Expert on Flood-Related Disaster mitigation to be held in Japan from 28<sup>th</sup> September 2009 to 18<sup>th</sup> September 2010. This programme is approved as a Master's Degree Program by the GRIPS and PWRI. The details of the programme and the application form may be drawn from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (**persmin.nic.in**).

2. The Program is designed for Organizations concerned with river management or water-related disasters. The overall goal of this training course is to reduce economics/social losses by water-related disasters in developing countries.

3. The Candidates should be Engineers or Technical Officers who have three or more years of experience in the field of flood management; be university graduates in Civil Engineering, especially of hydraulics and hydrology; be familiar with mathematics such as differentiation and integration techniques; be able to write research reports on the individual study in English; be proficient in MS Word, Excel and Power Point; be proficient at written and spoken English; be over twenty two and under forty years of age; be in good health, both physically and mentally to undergo the training and not be serving in the military.

4. The fellowship award covers a Round-trip air ticket between an international airport designated by the JICA and Japan; travel insurance from arrival to departure in Japan; allowances for (accommodation, living expenses, outfit and shipping); expenses for JICA study tours and free medical care for participants who may fall ill after reaching Japan. The participants are not allowed to take any family member during the training course.

5. It is requested that the nomination of the suitable candidates may please be forwarded to this Department in accordance with the eligibility criteria and the terms and conditions of the JICA's Circular dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2009. The Ministry/ State Governments may sponsor the names of only Government/ Public Sector Undertaking functionary.

6. The nomination details should be submitted in the JICA's prescribed proformas (A2A3 Forms), duly authenticated by the Department concerned alongwith the country report.

7. The applications should reach this Department <u>through proper channel</u> not later than 20<sup>th</sup> May 2009. Nominations received after the prescribed date will not be considered.
