OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub:- Grant of "NOC" to officers working under the Central Staffing Scheme to enable them to apply for Non-Central Staffing Scheme posts - reg.

In terms of the provisions of the Consolidated Deputation Guidelines for All India Services issued by DoP&T in its O.M. No. 14017/33/2005-AIS(II)(Pt.I) dated 28th November, 2007 and O.M. No. AB-14017/2/2007-Estt (RR) dated 29.2.2008 for members of the organized Group 'A' and Group 'B' Services of the Central Government, an officer's movement from a CSS to a Non-CSS post, or vice versa is permitted and the officer is eligible for an additional tenure of two years, subject to at least two years on either post.

2. This office had been receiving requests for shift of officers to Non-CSS posts before completion of two years in their present assignments. The matter had been under consideration of this Department. Now, the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the following:-

- (i) Lateral shift will not be normally allowed before completing two years on a CSS or Non-CSS post, as the case may be.
- (ii) If shifted before two years, the officer shall not be entitled to the additional tenure of two years over and above the normal tenure.
