2. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the following for making provisions in the existing policy for inter cadre transfer:

- (i) In cases where either of the officers cannot opt for the cadre of the spouse being their respective home cadre, the officers may choose the immediate next cadre opted by them in the detailed application form submitted to UPSC below the present cadre allotted.
- (ii) In case of non receipt of preference within the stipulated time from the concerned officers, they can be assigned the most deficit cadre between the two subject to receipt of No Objection Certificate from the parent cadre as well as recipient cadre.
