
Subject: **Opening of SPARROW window for a period of 15 days to migrate the PARs for the year 2014-15.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that in view of the requests from various quarters, it has been decided to open the window for SPARROW for a period of 15 days w.e.f. 07.01.2016 to 21.01.2016 for migrating of PARs in respect of financial year 2014-15.

2. The State Government are requested to ensure that only those PARs in respect of financial year 2014-15 **which have been recorded by the 31st of December, 2015** but could not be uploaded due to the closure of window for SPARROW may be migrating during this period. It may be noted that in terms of extant rules, any remarks recorded in the PAR after the 31st of December are to be treated as time-barred. It may kindly be further noted that **PARs which are not migrated to SPARROW upto 21.01.2016 would not be taken on record.**
