Subject: Acceptance of 'Free Companion Ticket' by Government servants and members of their families under the 'Companion Free Scheme' introduced from time to time by various Airlines - clarification regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer/ to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 5th March, 97 on the subject mentioned above wherein it was provided that Government servants may be permitted to accept the Free Companion Tickets or variations thereof provided that such benefits are restricted to travel by the national carriers (Indian Airlines and Air India). References have been received seeking clarification whether Government servant may be permitted to accept the 'Free Tickets' earned under the 'Flying Returns' schemes of Air India/Indian Airlines. It is clarified that since the O.M. dated 5.3.97 permits acceptance of Free Companion Tickets or variations thereof, there would be no objection to Government servants accepting the free tickets earned by them under Flying Returns schemes of Air India/Indian Airlines. /


