

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The undersigned is directed to say that commuted leave is granted to a gazetted government servant under rule 19(b)(i) of the CCS(Leave) Rules, 1972 on production of medical certificate from an A.M.S. only. This Department have been receiving a number of references from various Ministries/Departments that medical certificate issued from A.I.I.M.S., New Delhi, PGIM Chandigarh and JIPMER, Pondicherry may also be accepted for the purpose of grant of commuted leave to gazetted Govt. servants.

2. This has been under consideration of this Department for sometime and it has now been decided in consultation with the Ministries of Finance & Health that medical certificates issued by the above mentioned institutions may also be accepted for the purpose of grant of commuted leave to gazetted govt. servant/ non-gazetted government servants.

3. Insofar as persons serving in the Indian Audit & Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue in consultation with the C&AG.
