OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Framing of Recruitment Rules for Group 'C' and 'D'  
posts - Delegation of powers -

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's Office Memorandum No. CD.14017/10/85-Estt. (RR) dated the 21st March, 1985 wherein the Administrative Ministries/Departments have been delegated the powers to frame and amend Recruitment Rules for Group C and D posts under them (including their Attached and Subordinate Offices) after getting the Rules vetted by the Ministry of Law and subject to certain conditions. Certain Ministries/Departments have now approached this Department for clarification whether the above delegation of powers to the Administrative Ministries/Departments would also cover cases involving relaxation of provisions of the notified Recruitment Rules for Group C and D posts. The matter has been considered and it is hereby clarified that under the provisions of this Department's O.M. dated 21.3.85 referred to above, administrative Ministries/Departments are competent to relax the provisions of the notified Recruitment Rules for Group C and D posts coming under their administrative control.
