OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Transfer of Central Government- employees on deputation - Counting of period of deputation in more than one ex-cadre post - Amendment to Recruitment Rules.

.....

The undersigned is directed to invite attention to this Department's O.M. No.2(17)-Estt(P-II)/82 dated 27.4.1982 communicating the decision of the Government that when an officer on deputation in one organisation/department is appointed to another post in the same organisation/department, it should be treated as a case of continued deputation for the purpose of reckoning the maximum period of deputation. With a view to ensuring that this decision is implemented, the Ministries were called upon to make suitable amendments to the Recruitment Rules.

2. In order to have uniformity in the amendments to Recruitment Rules to be made as per the instructions referred to above, it has been decided in consultation with the U.P.S.C. that the revised provisions of the rules may be worded as follows:-

"(Period of deputation/contract* including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation/department shall ordinarily not exceed.....years)"


*To be added in cases in which method of recruitment has been laid down as "by transfer on deputation (including short-term contract)".

NOTE: In cases where the period of deputation is more than 3 years the word "ordinarily" will be omitted, idea being that in such cases there should not be any extension of deputation beyond the prescribed period.

3. For making this amendment the proposals may be taken up direct with the U.P.S.C. (without adopting the normal procedure of referring such cases first to this Department which will continue to be followed in all other types of amendments) and thereafter with the Legislative Department for vetting. A copy of the notification issued may, however, be endorsed to the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms. for information.
