OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules 1955-
Delegation of Powers.

Formal orders delegating to Heads of Departments certain powers under rules 8, 10 and 13 of the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, have been issued separately.

2. Rules 4(2), 13(d) and 14 of these Rules lay down that a Government servant shall make a report to Government of habitual indebtedness or insolvency and certain facts regarding himself or members of his family in the circumstances specified in those rules. Such reports should be submitted by the Government servant to his immediate superior who should forward it through the normal channels to the authority competent to remove or dismiss him from service. Except where such authority requires guidance or clarification from a higher authority it shall consider the report and pass appropriate orders on it. If any penalty is to be imposed on the Government servant, the procedure prescribed in the Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules will have to be followed. These instructions may be brought to the notice of all Government servants to whom these rules apply.
