**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject :-** Recommendations of the Fifth Central Pay Commission – Regulation of pay of Officers of Group 'A' on their appointment to posts in the Central Secretariat under the Central Staffing Scheme – Government decisions thereon.

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Reference is invited to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2001 on the above subject.

2. In para 8 of the said O.M. it has been laid down that these orders shall be effective from their date of issue and past cases of officers who have already completed their Central deputation and have reverted to their respective parent cadres shall not, however, be re-opened.

2. In partial modification of the above provision, it has now been decided that the orders issued vide O.M. dated 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2001 would equally apply to such of the officers also who were on deputation in the Centre during the period prior to 9.4.2001 but had repatriated to their cadres before that date.

3. This issues with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide their U.O. No. 110/1/2004-IC dated 23.2.2004.

4. In so far as the applicability of these orders to the officers of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department is concerned, these orders issue after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.


