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

Subject: Revision of rules relating to payment of Central Secretariat (Deputation on Tenure) Allowance (CDTA) to officers of Group 'A' Services on their appointment as Director in the Central Secretariat under the Central Staffing Scheme- Regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that earlier the ceiling of Rs.18,300 on pay plus CDTA had existed in respect of AIS as well as Central Group 'A' officers appointed to the post of Director on Central Deputation. This ceiling was removed in respect of AIS officers (including IAS, IPS and IFS) vide this department's notification dated 11.8.1998. The issue of reintroducing the maximum ceiling of Rs.18300 on pay plus CDTA in respect of AIS officers also with prospective effect was under consideration of the Government. However, considerable time having elapsed since issue of orders dated 11.8.98, it was not found possible to withdraw the orders which had been in force for 5 years. Accordingly, the issue for removing ceiling of Rs.18300 on pay plus CDTA in respect of Central Group 'A' officers appointed to the post of Director on Central Deputation from the date it was removed in respect of AIS officers was considered by the Government and it has been decided that the dispensation in respect of AIS officers shall equally apply to Central Group 'A' officers on their appointment as Director on Central Deputation. Consequently, the ceiling of Rs.18,300/- on Pay plus CDTA of Central Group 'A' officers appointed on Central Deputation to the post of Director stands removed w.e.f. 11.8.1998.

2. These orders issue in consultation with Ministry of Finance who had concurred with it vide Deptt. of Expenditure IC U.O.No. 110/1/2003/IC dated 19.2.2004.
3. In so far as application of these orders to officers of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department is concerned, these orders are being issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.


