OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Relaxation of age limits in the case of medical graduates who join the Army Medical Corps as short Service Regular Commissioned Officers for Civil appointments.

The Government of India have had under consideration; the question of relaxing the upper age limit, for permanent appointment to Civil posts, in the case of such of the medical graduates who join the Army Medical Corps as Short Service Regular Commissioned Officers. It has now been decided that the upper age limit for appointment to civil posts under the Central Government and Part 'C' States, which require medical qualifications, should, in their case, be relaxed upto 35 years.
