OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Crucial date for determining the age limit
for recruitment - Inclusion of a 'note' in the
recruitment rules - Recommendation of the
Committee on Subordinate Legislation.

The Committee on Subordinate Legislation (7th Lok Sabha) in their 15th Report, which has been presented to the Lok Sabha on 25.2.1983, has, inter alia, made the following recommendation:-

"10. In order to ensure that such lacuna do not occur in other rules to be framed in future, the Committee emphasise that the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms should impress upon all the Ministries/Departments that whenever any Recruitment Rule involving direct recruitment is notified in the Gazette of India, they should ensure that the column regarding determining the age limit should invariably contain the note regarding crucial date on the pattern as contained in the case of Central Board of Film Censors, Bombay (Junior Stenographer and Mazdoor) Recruitment Rules,*1980".


(* The note contained in the above mentioned Rules reads as follows:-

"Note: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (other than those in Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep). In the case of recruitment made through the Employment Exchange, the crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the last date upto which the Employment Exchange is asked to submit the names."

2. Suitable instructions to the above effect are already contained in para 3.8.1 of the guidelines issued by this Department vide O.M. No.14017/24/76-Estt.(RR) dated the 22nd May, 1979. It may be clarified that in the case of recruitment rules for Group A and B posts, it is adequate that the 'note' containing the first sentence only is inserted, while in the case of recruitment rules for

Group C and D posts the complete note along with the second sentence should be incorporated.

3. The above recommendation of the Committee on Subordinate Legislation is brought to the notice of all the Ministries/Departments for compliance while framing the recruitment rules for posts under them. The recruitment rules already notified by them may also please be revised and necessary amendments made in case the existing provisions do not conform to the instructions.
