OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Payment of additional dearness allowance to Central Government employees - Revised rates effective from 1st June, 1981.

.....

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.13016/1/81-E.II(B) dated 21st September, 1981 on the above mentioned subject and to say that the President is pleased to decide that the rates of additional dearness allowance specified in para 1 of that O.M. will stand modified as follows with effect from 1st June, 1981.

Pay Range	Rates of additional dearness allowance per mensem.
i) Upto Rs.300/-	65.5% of pay, subject to a minimum of Rs.35/- plus 48% of pay and a maximum of Rs.194/-
ii) Above Rs.300/- and upto Rs.400/-	Rs. 62/- plus 44% of pay.
iii) Above Rs.400/- and upto Rs.800/-	48.5% of pay, subject to a minimum of 15.5% of pay plus Rs.176/-
iv) Above Rs.800/- and upto Rs.900/-	Rs.100/- plus 36% of pay.
v) Above Rs.900/- and upto Rs.1000/-	Rs.127/- plus 33% of pay.
vi) Above Rs.1000/- and upto Rs.1600/-	Rs.457/-
vii) Above Rs.1600/- and upto Rs.1660/-	Amount by which pay falls short of Rs.2057/-
viii) Above Rs.1660/- and upto Rs.2000/-	Rs.397/-

2. The total dearness allowance as well as additional dearness allowance on the pay above Rs.200/- will be regulated as indicated in para 2 of this Ministry's OM No. 13017/3/81-E-II(B) dated 14.7.1981.

3. The payment on account of dearness allowance and additional dearness allowance will be rounded off to the nearest 10 paise.
4. In regard to Armed Forces personnel and civilian employees paid from the Defence Service Estimates and Railway Employees, necessary orders will be issued by the Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Railways respectively.
5. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
