Sub: IAS (Pay) Rules, 1954 - Amendment to Rule 7 -

Sir,

I am directed to say that consequent on the revision of scales of pay of the IAS officers with effect from 1.1.73 vide Central Government Notification No. 28/7/74-AIS(II) dated the 13th November, 1974, the junior scale prescribed is 700-40-900-EB-40-1100-50-1300. In the existing scale, the IAS probationers draw their first increment as soon as they complete first year of service and as the probationers have to undergo training in the National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie, during the first nine months of their service, it is not possible for them to pass the prescribed departmental examination/examinations within the first year of their service and as a result they are unable to get first two increments simultaneously for passing the departmental examination as prescribed under rule 7 of the IAS (Pay) Rules, 1954. In order to remove this difficulty and enable them to get second and third advanced increments, the Central Government have proposed to amend Rule 7 of the IAS (Pay) Rules, 1954, as in the draft notification enclosed. The concurrence/comments of the State Government may be sent as early as possible.

2. In case comments are not received by the 30th November, 1978, the concurrence of the State Government shall be presumed.


