Subject: IAS/IPS/IFS (Pay) Rules - Grant of next increment in  
the revised scales to officers who were drawing pay  
in the pre-revised scales having fixed pay.

.....

Sir,

I am directed to say that the question of grant of  
increment, as on 1.1.86, for stagnating at the maximum of  
the pay scale for more than one year, under the third proviso  
to sub-rule (3A) of Rule 5 of the IAS (Pay) Rules, 1954, in  
respect of members of the service who have been getting a  
fixed pay of Rs.3000/- for more than one year on 1.1.86 has  
been considered. It has been decided that since there is no  
minimum and maximum in the case of fixed pay, the question  
of allowing the next increment from 1.1.1986 under the afore-  
said rule does not arise. Accordingly, the officers who were  
drawing fixed pay of Rs.3000/- prior to 1.1.1986 would draw  
their next increment in the revised scale of Rs.7300-7600, on  
completion of 12 months service, i.e. on 1.1.1987. These  
instructions apply mutatis mutandis to members of the IPS/IFS.
