Sub: - IAS/IPS - Officiating promotion in short term vacancies on a duration of 60 days or more.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to this Department letter No. 1/58/70-AIS(II) dated 30th June, 1971 in which it was decided that officiating promotions for short-term vacancies in the selection grade of the IAS/IPS may be granted when the vacancies are of the duration of 90 days or more, and to say that the question of issuing similar instructions in regard to the super time scale posts has been under consideration. It has now been decided that officiating promotions to short-term vacancies in the super time scale in the IAS/IPS may henceforth be granted where such vacancies are of a duration of 45 days or more. The promotions should not be allowed in respect of a chain of vacancies, comprising of shorter periods but which when taken together extend beyond the period of 45 days. This issues with the concurrence of the Pay Unit of the Establishment Division of this Department vide their u.o. No. 3518-PUI/79 dated 19.10.1979.
