1954 - Fixation of pay in the revised scales  
of pay -

Sir,

I am directed to say to refer to this Department's Notification No.28/7/74-AIS (II), dated the 15th November, 1974, on the subject cited above, and to say that a question has been raised whether the pay of a member of the Indian Administrative Service, who opts for the revised senior scale of the Indian Administrative Service from a date subsequent to 1-1-1973 would be fixed in accordance with the provisions contained in sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of the Indian Administrative Service (Pay) Rules, 1954, as amended through the above-mentioned Notification dated the 15th November, 1974.

2. The Government of India have decided that the pay of a member of the Indian Administrative Service who opts for the revised senior scale of the Indian Administrative Service from a date subsequent to 1-1-1973 but not later than 31-12-1974 will be fixed in the revised senior scale of the I.A.S. in accordance with the provision contained in sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of the Indian Administrative Service (Pay) Rules, 1954. In the case of such Officers, the "existing emoluments" or pay for the purpose of fixation of pay in the revised scale will include D.A., D.P. & Interim Relief at the rates in force on 31-12-1972. The pay of members of the Service who opt for the revised scale of pay from a date subsequent to 31-12-1974 may be fixed on the analogy of the provisions contained in the Fundamental rules.

3. The above principles may also be adopted in the case of fixation of pay of members of the Indian Police Service/Indian Forest Service in the revised scales of pay.

4. This issues in consultation with the Ministry of Finance.
